Required Notification of School Incident

Under Texas House Bill 473 and the subsequent HB 3, Texas public schools are required to notify parents of significant threats on campus.

Yesterday after school hours, we were made aware of a concerning statement made by a student at Brackett High School. Today, we fully investigated the allegation and appropriate disciplinary action has been taken in regards to the threat. In addition, the Kinney County Sheriff Department immediately responded and addressed the situation and the suspect. Law enforcement has taken appropriate action.

I want to thank our local law enforcement partners and Brackett High School administration for the quick response to this situation. I am incredibly grateful to the students who reported the comments. We have informed our students about the importance of hear something, see something – SAY SOMETHING. We always encourage anyone with knowledge about threats, whether they are credible or not, to immediately inform campus administration or another trusted adult on campus.

In closing, I want to encourage you to please talk to your children about the serious nature of making threats because those words can lead to significant legal consequences. It is also important to remind students to report suspicious or concerning behavior

Thank you for helping keep Brackett ISD safe, and for partnering with us in the education of our students. Students safety is our top priority and it is safe for your child to attend school.
