At the district level, the overall rating moved from 81/B to 76/C. Our **School Progress score remained at 80/B**, and our **Academic Growth moved from 72/C to 80/B (+8 points)**. Those indicators reflect areas where our students and staff are making progress. The primary factor contributing to the lower district rating is Brackett High School's current "C" rating.

Campus Results

Jones Elementary improved its overall score from 71/C to 74/C. School Progress and Academic Growth both increased by four points, and Closing the Gaps remained at 70.

Brackett Junior High maintained its overall score of 76/C. Student Achievement increased one point, School Progress increased one point, and Academic Growth increased two points. These gains are encouraging, although we did see declines in Relative Performance and Closing the Gaps.

Brackett High School declined its overall score from 91/A to 78/C. Academic Growth increased from 70/C to 85/B, and the graduation rate remained at 100%. Student Achievement remained at 80/B.

The **College Career Military Readiness (CCMR) component** at the high school dropped from 92 to 72. CCMR impacts all measured domains at the high school. An in-depth review determined that Brackett High School's actual CCMR completion rate was 100%. However, the district identified a campus-level reporting discrepancy that significantly impacted results reported to the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

Because the discrepancy originated from a local reporting issue, it does not meet the criteria for an appeal. Although the district's internal records accurately reflect a 100% CCMR completion rate, the data reported to TEA remains the official data used for accountability purposes.
